A 2700-point aggregate to be fired during March 31 & April 1, 2012.

It is NRA Registered and NYSRPA approved for the New York State Indoor Pistol Championship.

RANGE DIRECTIONS

Latitude 42.10082N Longitude 75.86517W

The range is located on NY route 7 (579 Conklin Road) about 150 yards outside the Binghamton City Limits.

If approaching from the North, Northeast on I-88, or West on I-86 (NY17), take I-81 South and use exit 3, Industrial Park/Colesville Rd. Turn right on Colesville Rd. Turn left at the second traffic light (just past the Love's Gas Station) and follow the signs to route 7. See *.

If approaching from the East, use I-86 (NY17) exit 75 to route 11 and proceed about 1.3 miles from the exit. Turn right at the first traffic light past the overpass and follow the signs to route 7. See *.

If approaching from the South, take I-81 North and use exit 2W to route 11. Proceed about 1.2 miles from exit 2W. Turn right at the first traffic light past the overpass and follow route 7 South signs. See *.

* Take the bridge over the river and turn left on route 7 North. The range is about 1.4 miles up route 7 on the right side of the road, the second building past Cottman Transmissions, sitting far back from the road.

ELIGIBILITY

All shooters are encouraged to be members of the NRA, but it is not required. To establish National Records the shooter must be a member of the NRA. To be eligible for New York State awards, all shooters must belong to either the New York State Rifle & Pistol Association or their home state organization. Membership cards must be presented at the time of registration. Membership applications will be available at the range. *Each competitor will be required to fill out and sign an information sheet to be sent to the NYSRPA.*

CLASSIFICATION

NRA classification will be used. Unclassified shooters will compete in the Master Class, unless a verified average from an NRA registered league or a temporary record book is presented in lieu of a classification card. Proof of classification will be required at the range and is subject to verification at the NRA website.

RELAYS

All 22 caliber relays will be limited to that caliber only. CF and 45 calibers may be squadded together. Six relays will be fired on Saturday, March 31st, starting at 8:00 AM sharp. Six relays will be fired on Sunday, April 1st, starting at 8:00 AM sharp.

FACILITIES

The 50-foot range has fifteen firing positions with automatic turning target holders that return to the firing line allowing rapid target changes. We have a waiting room, rest rooms, and ample parking space. Breakfast and Lunch will be available, as well as snacks all day.

SQUADDING

Range capabilities restrict entries to 60 3-gun competitors. Squadding preference will be given to 3-gun shooters. One- and two-gun shooters will be accepted as facilities permit. One-gun shooters may be assigned to CF/45 relays, but only if necessary. Squadding will be on a first-come, first-served basis. In order to confirm your requested squadding position, we **MUST** receive your completed registration form and your **TOTAL ENTRY FEE**. We will hold telephone and e-mail requests for squadding positions for 72 hours, but cannot guarantee those positions after 72 hours unless we have received your completed registration form and fee.

TEAM SCORES

Individual scores from the Gallery Course will constitute the team score for each caliber. **TEAM ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED AT THE STATISTICAL OFFICE PRIOR TO ANY TEAM MEMBER FIRING THE GALLERY COURSE!!!!** *A team will consist of only four members with each member shooting all 3 calibers.* Team members must belong to the same sponsoring organization. Pick-up teams are not permitted.

BRC MATCH AWARDS

Awards will be **CASH ONLY**. One first place **OPEN** award will be given for each match. One class award will be given for every five shooters in each class. If there are less than 5 shooters in a class, that class will be combined with the next higher class. If after combining there are less than 5 High Masters, they will compete for the open award only. **OPEN** award winners will not be eligible for class awards in that match. In any class, if there are fewer than five shooters in the police or military categories, those categories will be combined. If this still results in less than five shooters, this category will be merged with the civilian category. There will be a **HIGH WOMAN** award for match 16 if there are 3 or more 3-gun woman shooters. There will be a **HIGH SENIOR** award for match 16 if there are 3 or more 3-gun senior shooters. Our policy is to return, as prizes, 50% of the entry fees, after expenses.

NYSRPA AWARDS

The New York State Rifle & Pistol Association will award prizes, within the categories listed below, for scores fired by individuals and teams at this and other ranges holding the New York State Championships.

SCORING

The Statistical Office will score targets off line. Plug-type scoring gauges may be used only by the Chief Statistical Officer, the Match Director or the Referee or Jury Chairman and then only upon request by the affected competitor. Competitors will have one hour after firing their last relay to challenge scoring. After that time, scores may not be challenged.

SOUVENIR AWARDS

At the discretion of the Binghamton Rifle Club, prizes will be awarded for firing a perfect score (PS); i.e., all 10s or Xs on the first or second 10-shot string of a 20-shot match or a 10-shot string of the Gallery Course. Competitors are eligible for only one PS award.

ENTRIES

Entries received by 24 March 2012 will be sent a confirmation notice indicating squadding information. All entries must include a completed registration form or equivalent information and all fees for the matches you will shoot. Telephone requests for squadding preference will be held for 72 hours only, by which time the mail entry must be received. Entry fees above the \$15.00 registration fee will be returned to those unable to attend.

RULES

NRA Rules will govern throughout.

EYE PROTECTION MUST BE WORN WHEN SHOOTING ON THE BINGHAMTON RIFLE CLUB RANGE. EAR PROTECTION IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED.

ONLY LEAD OR MID-RANGE COPPER PLATED TARGET LOADS ARE ALLOWED.

LODGING

Convenient lodging is available at several nearby motels.

FEES

All fees are payable in advance to secure squadding position. The registration fee includes fees to the NRA (\$5.50) and the NYSRPA (\$6.00) and for the Final Bulletin.

1-Gun: 4 Matches + Aggregate = \$25.00 (Includes Registration Fee)

2-Gun: 8 Matches + Aggregate = \$38.00 (Includes Registration Fee)

3-Gun: 12 Matches + Aggregate = \$50.00 (Includes Registration Fee)

Team Match: \$12.00 per 4-man team (state membership required)

All team match prizes will be awarded by the NYSRPA based on statewide competition.

COURSES OF FIRE

Ten shots will be fired per target for all stages of all 22 caliber matches and five shots per target for all stages of all CF/45 caliber matches. Five minutes will be allowed for each five shots in all slow fire stages of all CF/45 matches. The range for all matches will be 50 feet.

Telephone and e-mail entries will be held for 72 hours to allow you to mail your entry. If any choice is filled, you will be assigned the closest to it. Please plan to be through registration at the Statistical Office at least one-half hour before your relay time.
